The purpose of the evaluation was to promote institutional learning to improve the implementation of future “relief” actions and more specifically food distribution of the RC in Lebanon. Out of the Box assessed the projects relevance and effectiveness and made recommendations to improve future performance of other relief actions.

Evaluation of Self Help Africa's Irish Aid funded Programme grant in Uganda from 2012-2016. The objective was to evaluate the three projects in the programme; generate key lessons; identify areas for continued advocacy and evaluate the effectiveness of Self Help Africa's integrated programme approach.

## LOCATION: LEBANON

### **○ SEARCH FOR COMMON GROUND (SFCG)**

#### BASELINE ASSESSMENT

The overall objective of the project is for "Syrian refugees and Lebanese host communities to consistently apply collaborative, conflict sensitive and non-violent response to rising communal tensions." Out of the box through this assessment, highlighted what a more 'conflict-sensitive' project approach look like based on the needs of the different targeted communities



## LOCATION: LEBANON

### SEARCH FOR COMMON GROUND (SFCG)

#### BASELINE ASSESSMENT

The main aim of the project “Tourathing – Protecting our Future: A Youth-led Approach to the Promotion of Lebanese Cultural Heritage” is to promote and protect Lebanese cultural heritage.

The objectives of the baseline study were to determine local perceptions and attitudes towards local and national cultural heritage in Lebanon, and to further refine the project design and help tailor activities to be context specific, by improving the understanding around the dynamics within and between the targeted local communities and the different perceptions, attitudes and behaviors at stake.



## LOCATION: ETHIOPIA

### SAVE THE CHILDREN EVALUATION

An evaluation of a three year project ‘*Improving Maternal Newborn and Child Health*’ in North Gondar Zone of Amhara region, Ethiopia’ which was implemented from December 2010 to July 2013.

The objectives of the evaluation were:

- To assess the progress made towards the overall goal and objectives of the project based on the project log frame and achievements for each specific result and indicator;
- To assess the effectiveness of the project in meeting the needs of boys, girls, men and women in the community;
- To identify lessons learnt and good practices from the project which could be applied to future and other on-going projects



## LOCATION: MALAWI, BENIN, GHANA, SIERRA LEONE, NIGERIA AND SOUTH SUDAN

### ○ MISEAN CARA EFFECTIVENESS REVIEW

An Effectiveness Review of projects supporting realisation of girls' equal education rights in Africa. This review assessed the effectiveness of 10 educational projects across six countries in realising girls' equal rights to, in and through education.

The strategic objectives of the Effectiveness Review included:

1. To produce a robust evaluation of the effectiveness of the selected projects in realising girls' equal rights, to, in and through education.
2. To provide evidence of effectiveness that will contribute to future planning for the evaluated projects and Member Organisations responsible, and help them to attract the resources necessary for continued development and sustainability, as well as to contribute to Misan Cara's annual review, analysis and reporting processes.
3. To identify those project activities/interventions of proven effectiveness which have potential for replication in other contexts
4. To contribute to Misan Cara's communications agenda through the capture of appropriate and relevant photographic material

## LOCATION: UGANDA & RWANDA

### ○ DEFENDDEFENDERS EVALUATION

Evaluation of DefendDefenders' Program 2011 to 2016. The purpose of the evaluation was to assess effectiveness, relevance, efficiency, impact, and sustainability of DefendDefenders' work in the past five years (2011-2016).

## LOCATION: ETHIOPIA

### ○ COMITATO COLLABORAZIONE MEDICA (CCM) EVALUATION

An evaluation of CCM health project "*Strengthening of the Network and Improvement of the Quality of Reproductive Health Services in Bale Zone (Oromia, Ethiopia)*" from 2014 until 2017. The objectives of the evaluation were to evaluate the relevance, efficiency, effectiveness, impact and sustainability of the project.



